- The winning NATION will be the one whose top 6 sailors in the final overall standings accumulate the lowest score. (4 Men, 1 Woman, 1 U21)
- The winning CLUB will be the one whose top 4 sailors in the final overall standings accumulate the lowest score. (2 Men, 1 Woman, 1 U21)
- Any NATION or CLUB that does not meet the quota of 6 or 4 sailors, respectively, will be assigned points equal to the last-placed sailor who finished at least one race + 1 point for each missing spot to complete the team.
- In the event of a tie in the NATIONS or CLUBS standings, priority will be given to the Nation or Club with the highest number of total participants who finished at least one race in the regatta.
- If a sailor qualifies as both Male/Female and U21, they will compete either as Male/Female or as U21, leaving the other position vacant.
